



POOL GUARD POOL PAINT – APPLICATION GUIDELINES.

Notes on PREPARATION

• In case of water seepage due to cracks in the structure or surface, HPG has a range of products available for this. Please enquire with your relevant branch.

IMPORTANT INFO

- Do not cover the pool during the curing period after the 2nd coat.
- Once re-filled avoid sprinkling granular chlorine directly into the water, rather add chlorine via the weir to pass through the sand filter.
- All pool paints will eventually fade in colour when exposed to the chemical dosing of water. Prolonged colour fastness can be achieved with regularly maintaining the correct water balance.
- PoolGuard Pool Paint should not be used in hot tubs and spas, due to high water temperatures.
- Use of Platinum Pool Paint on surfaces not mentioned herein is not recommended.
- Avoid thick layering of 1st or 2nd coats to prevent blistering / immersion.
- Over-application will extend both the minimum overcoating periods and handling times and may be detrimental to the long-term overcoating properties.
